INTRODUCTION

This document offers an easy, convenient way for authors to list their book(s) in as many internet locations as possible – for FREE. Whether you're an eBook author, a print author, or you have sample chapters you'd like to make available, these free sites are a valuable resource that will help you increase sales.

You'll find free listing sites, link exchange sites, nominal-fee sites, review sites, sites where you can offer free chapters, get interviewed and post reviews.

I can absolutely guarantee that these sites will go a long way in bringing your book and potential customers together. How can I be so sure? These are the very same FREE sites I used to put my own eBook: [How To Publish & Market Your eBook For Just \\$5 \(http://www.authorscafe.com\)](http://www.authorscafe.com) on the publisher's best sellers' list for almost a year. At one time, it was ranked #2 in non-fiction.

I didn't spend a lot of money. I won't spend a lot of money. The success of my own eBook was a direct result of three things: the free listing sites I'm sharing with you; publishing an eZine (using the FREE Topica service) and writing articles that I give away on the internet.

To make submitting your book as fast and easy as possible, I suggest you have the following items prepared in advance:

- The URL where readers can purchase your book
- A brief paragraph prepared that will tell people about your book
- An author biography
- A small gif or jpg image of the book cover
- A small author photo
- A zipped PDF file of sample chapters
- Keywords that describe your book and will enable readers to find it by topic
- A review of your eBook, ready to post
- A banner ad – there is a list of free banner making sites near the end of this eDoc
- Sign up for a free eMail addy (Hotmail, Yahoo!, Lycos) because many of these sites ask for an eMail, and you don't want to give out your main address in case the list is sold.

There are several categories that allow you to list various services, articles, interviews, etc. Be careful though, I made a typo in my ad for [BookCoverExpress.com](http://www.bookcoverexpress.com) (<http://www.bookcoverexpress.com>) and there’s no way to fix it, so there it sits, a tribute to carelessness and a negative advertisement for my company.
